Consider your dietary habits and daily routine, as aligners need to be removed for eating and cleaning.

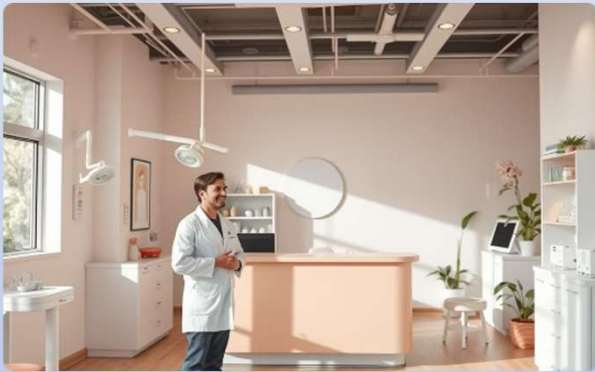
Budget

Store your aligners in their case when not wearing them to protect them from damage.

Follow-Up Appointments

Schedule regular appointments with your dentist for checkups and adjustments.
